

7TH ANNUAL SPARTAN FISHING TOURNAMENT

TOURNAMENT FORMAT AND RULES

There are two divisions in this multi-species tournament, inshore and offshore. Each boat will be provided with a “catch log” to record all qualifying catches by registered anglers. Each boat should also have a digital camera on board to take pictures of their fish. All logs must be turned in at the BBQ following the tournament for scoring. Once all of the scores have been calculated awards (along with bragging rights or shame) will be presented. The categories are as follows:

Inshore Division (Team)

- 1st Place Team
- 2nd Place Team
- 3rd Place Team

Offshore Division (Team)

- 1st Place Team
- 2nd Place Team
- 3rd Place Team

Overall (Individual)

- Biggest Fish
- Smallest Fish
- Top Jr. Angler
- Top Guided Male
- Top Guided Female
- Top Un-guided Male Angler
- Top Un-guided Female Angler

Scoring will be based on a point system. Points have been assigned to account for the difficulty in catching a particular species. Up to 25 fish of each of the following species may be counted.

INSHORE SPECIES

Tarpon - 15
Snook- 8 (28")
Redfish- 5 (18")
Trout- 2 (15")
Tripletail- 8
Permit- 20
Bonefish- 20

OFFSHORE SPECIES

Dolphin-6 (20")
Wahoo - 16
Tuna (yellow)- 8 (27")
Tuna (black)- 6
Sailfish- 20
Amberjack- 4
Kingfish- 6 (24")
Bonito- 4

OTHER

Grouper- 4 (24")
Shark- 3
Barracuda- 1
Jack- 1
Mackerel- 1
Flounder- 2
Cobia- 8
Snapper- 1 (16")

* DOUBLE POINTS FOR ANY FISH THAT MEASURES AT LEAST THE MINIMUM LENGTH LISTED *

Minimum lengths have been listed next to each species this applies to. If no length is listed, all fish of that species will be worth the same number of points.
